- Students wear Woomera/Cooby team shirts, sport shorts, shoes and socks to school over the top of swimmers. Please remember water-bottles, sunscreen and a hat. Students will need to wear a sun-shirt/team shirt throughout the day. Students are not required to wear sun-shirts while competing, but asked to wear them while spectating to remain sun-safe!
- Tuckshop orders need to be placed on Thursday in a brown paper bag as usual, using the special Swimming Carnival Tuckshop Menu. Parents are welcome to make purchases on the day.
- Tea and coffee for parents is available at the Pool Kiosk (and they have a fantastic new coffee machine!)
- There is not a designated lunch break. Students are encouraged to eat throughout the day when they are not required to swim.
- The Prep, Year 1 and Year 2 students may return to school with their teachers when their races are complete.
- The Cassowary Coast Southern Zone Carnival is held early next year so times from this carnival for the 8 12 yr age groups are used for nominations.
